# Data Flow and Setting Expectations

- We expect data to be submitted to the MAARC routinely
- We will monitor recruitment very closely and will likely recruit the MAARC and/or CTC to assist with preparing monthly reports
- Data must be archived and shared to the extent possible
- We encourage collaborative and cross-hub projects early & often

# Core Measures: Where to Start

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- **Purpose of Core Measures:**

- Allow comparisons across studies
- Facilitate secondary data use, including powering questions that can only be addressed with pooled data (e.g., low base rates)

- **Task:** Define parameters of what makes sense for JCOIN 2.0 CDEs

- Segmented by Intercept Point?

- **Don't reinvent the wheel** – start with the currently established measures and determine what needs to be adjusted

- JCOIN 1.0
- RISE Network
- CONNECT

# Core Measures/CDEs – Getting More Granular

For Self-Report, Survey, or Coded Data, Think About Level of Measurement

- Clinical Outcomes
  - Individual Participant
- Organizational Outcomes/Context
  - Staff
  - Leadership
  - Implementation
- Administrative Data
  - Anything that could be coded/abstracted consistently?

# Choosing CDEs

- We will chart the course for CDEs together – our approach will be pragmatic, but also pushing to maximize scientific synergies
- **Next steps:**
  - In the **next month**, each study intercept group should meet at least once to have a starting point discussion
    - Review existing CDE sets
    - Discuss what is practical & what is missing
  - **Do this even if we are unavailable to join**
  - **Need co-chairs** for each intercept point – R01 + RM1/UM1 co-chairs
  - Also need a group to discuss **implementation science** common measures
- **Goal:** Finalize CDE guidance for network within first 3-4 months
