Early Fall 2026	Project Refinements CERRC/Practitioner Board CAB Feedback as appropriate
Early November	Final Concepts submitted to NIDA • Similar to a supplement application, with caveats/nuances • Each project will only need to be submitted once for review
December 31	Target date for all final approvals
