Prisons are too important to be understudied

Lack of information, logistical issues, and hesitancy by prison officials and IRB may make it challenging.

Create entry points

- Use different methods historical, legal, interview, and statistical data collection and analysis.
- Look for converging events legal challenges, media attention, security concerns of prison officials.
- Network attend meetings, volunteer.

Sticky Issues

- Reflect on the emotional toll of bearing witness.
- Be prepared to face ethical issues.

TAKE-AWAYS

- ✓ Prison research has a set of unique challenges, but they are not insurmountable.
- ✓ The U.S. prison system is too big and too impactful to remain understudied.
- ✓ As more researchers look to add pixels to our image of U.S. prisons, they might keep in mind collaboration is key; and don't shy away from the sticky issues. Explore them. Keep exploring them.
